

# Coaches Code of Conduct

Play Sports Hawaii requires coaches to read and sign the “Coaches Code of Conduct” to ensure all of our coaches understand what is involved and expected of them when coaching a team in this league.

You are setting the example for your players and parents. We expect that you must be the best example that you can be.

It is your duty to know and understand the rules of the game, as well as teach the rules to your players to the best of your ability.

Check to make certain that each player is wearing the proper equipment and uniform for practice and for games.

Coaches are required to have a positive attitude and demonstrate good sportsmanship and encouragement to all their players and with other coaches.

Using profanity during practices or games will not be tolerated. The first offense will result in a 10yd penalty and dismissal from the game and/or game forfeiture. Future offenses can result in termination from coaching in this league.

Coaches should always be respectful and courteous when dealing with players, parents, and league officials.

NO ONE should be making any negative comments to the referees and only the Head Coach is able to approach the referees in a RESPECTABLE manner if he/she has any questions. We have reports of some coaches "riding" the refs, the entire game. Failure to abide by this will result in game forfeiture.

This youth flag football league is designed to educate the children in the basics of flag football and to provide them a fun experience.

It is imperative that coaches promote themselves and the league in a positive manner at all times, as your actions are a reflection of Play Sports Hawaii.

All coaches for Play Sports Hawaii must understand and agree to follow the rules of the “Coaches Code of Conduct.”
